and older brothers and sisters.

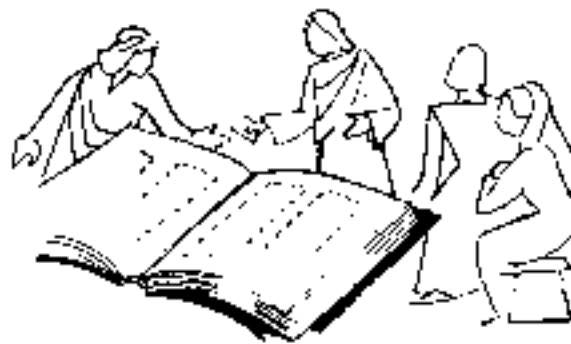


Why? Because they all like to read about

instead of in the book.



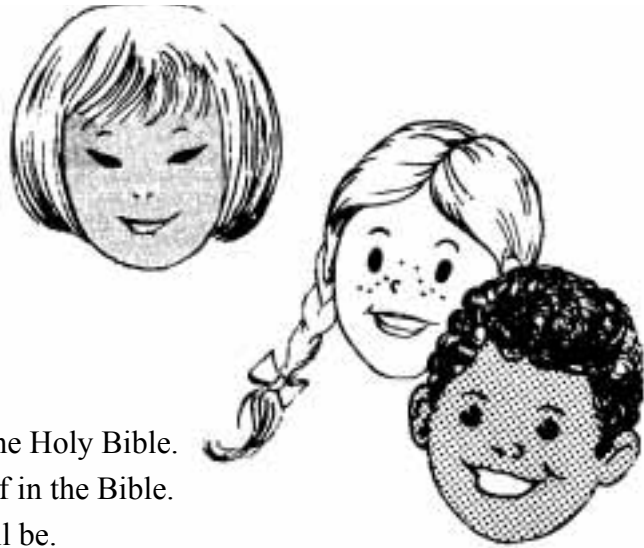

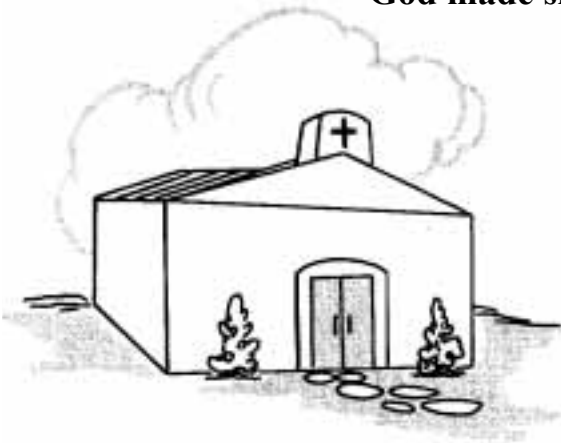
## God made a good world for you to live in.

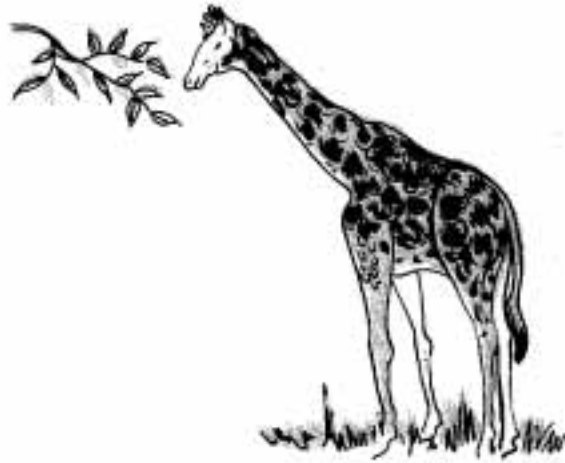

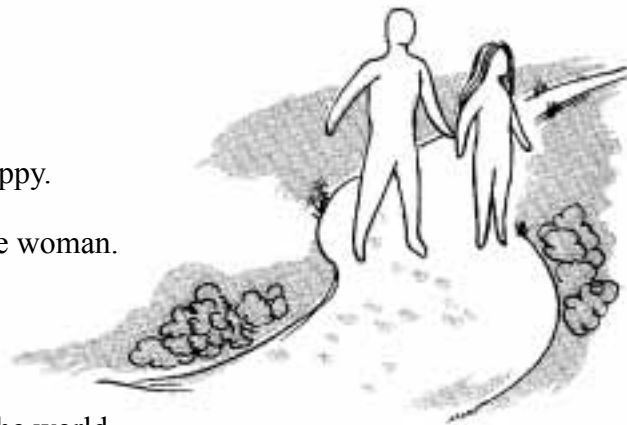

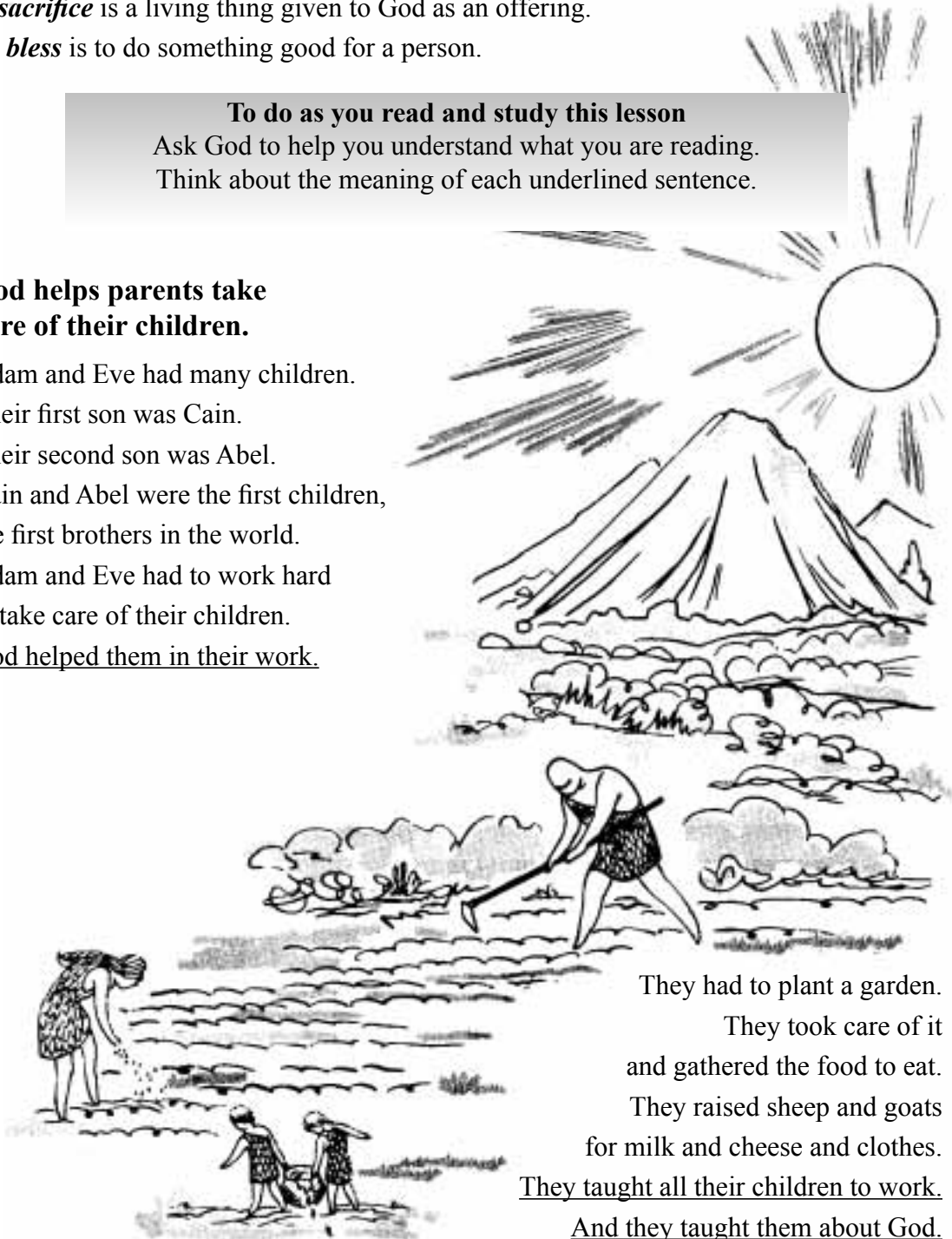

Cain killed his brother Abel.

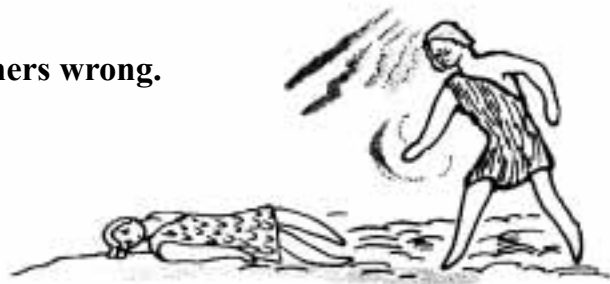
That was a terrible sin.

**God wants you to be good to others.**

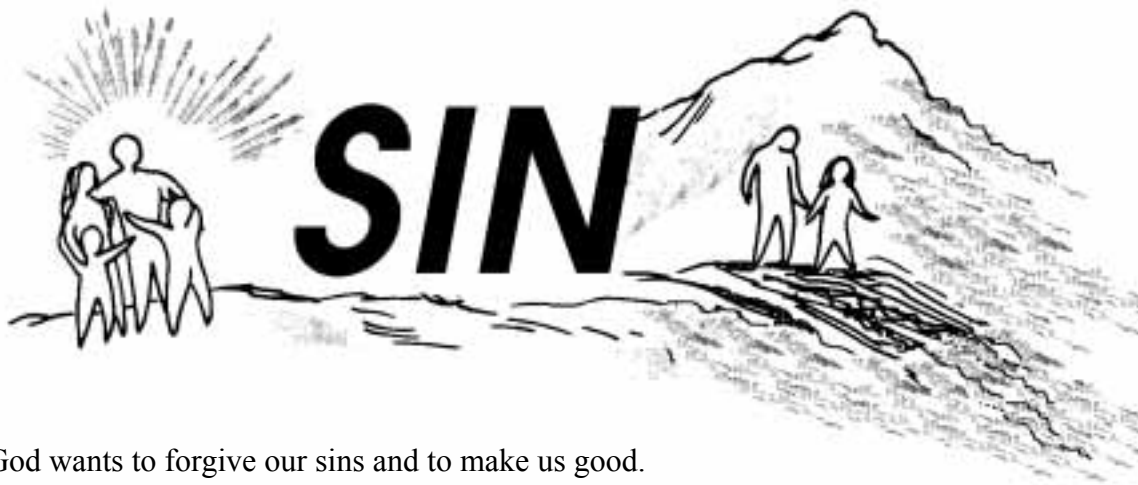
It is a sin to hate other people.

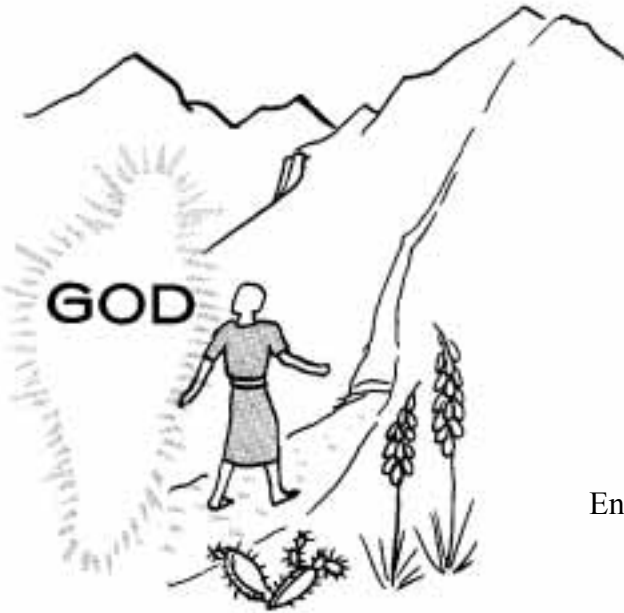


But many people did not love God.

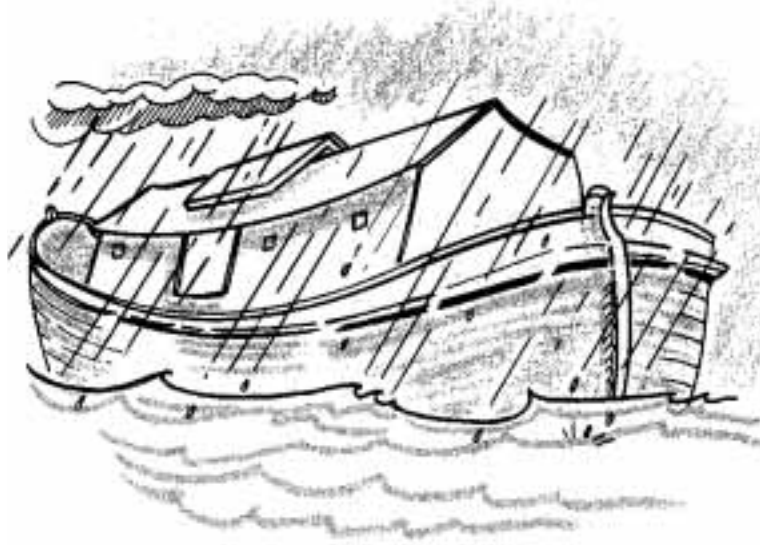

Everyone in it would be good.

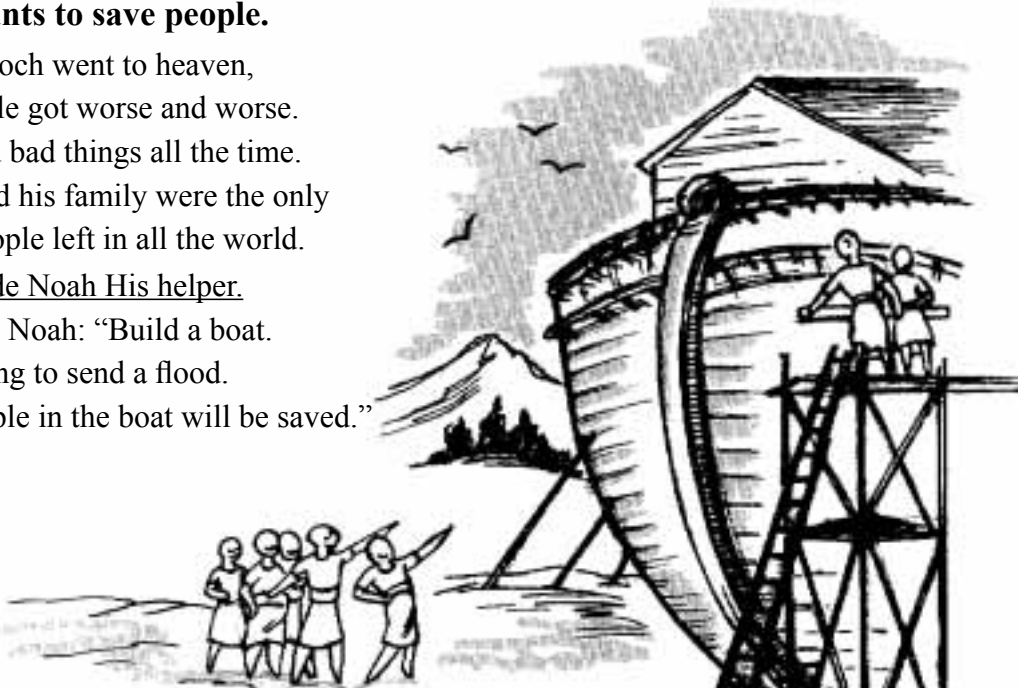


## God wants to save people.

good people left in all the world.

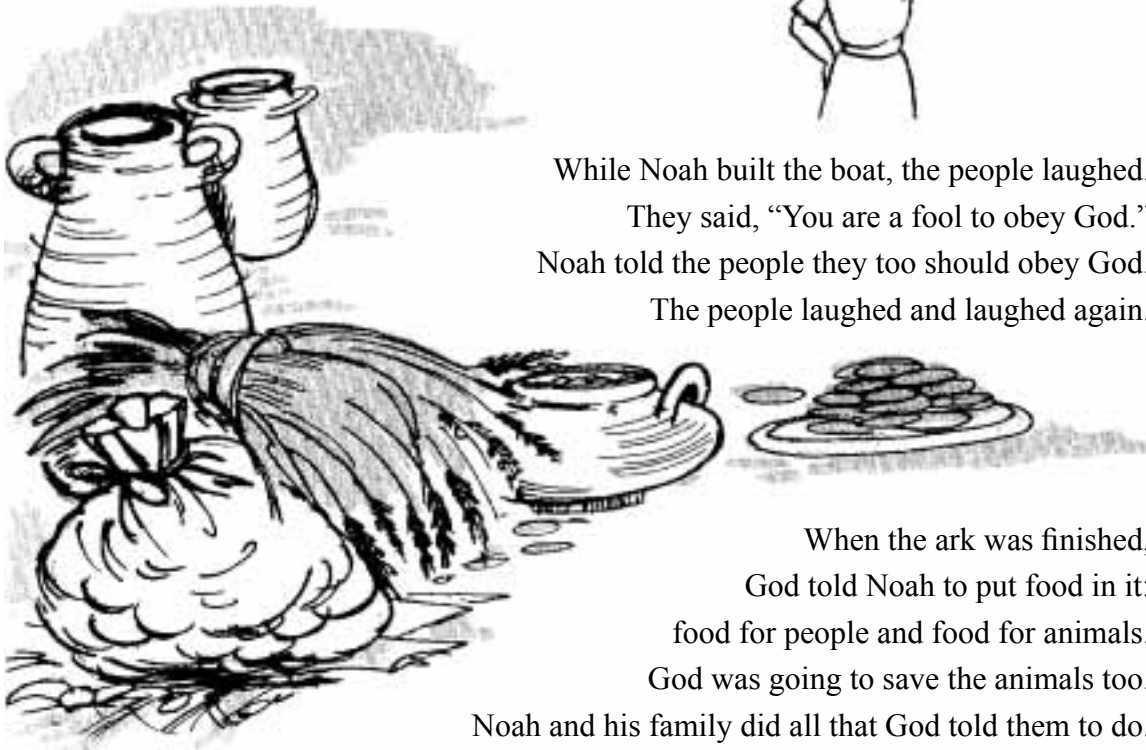
God made Noah His helper.

believed God and helped Noah get the boat ready.

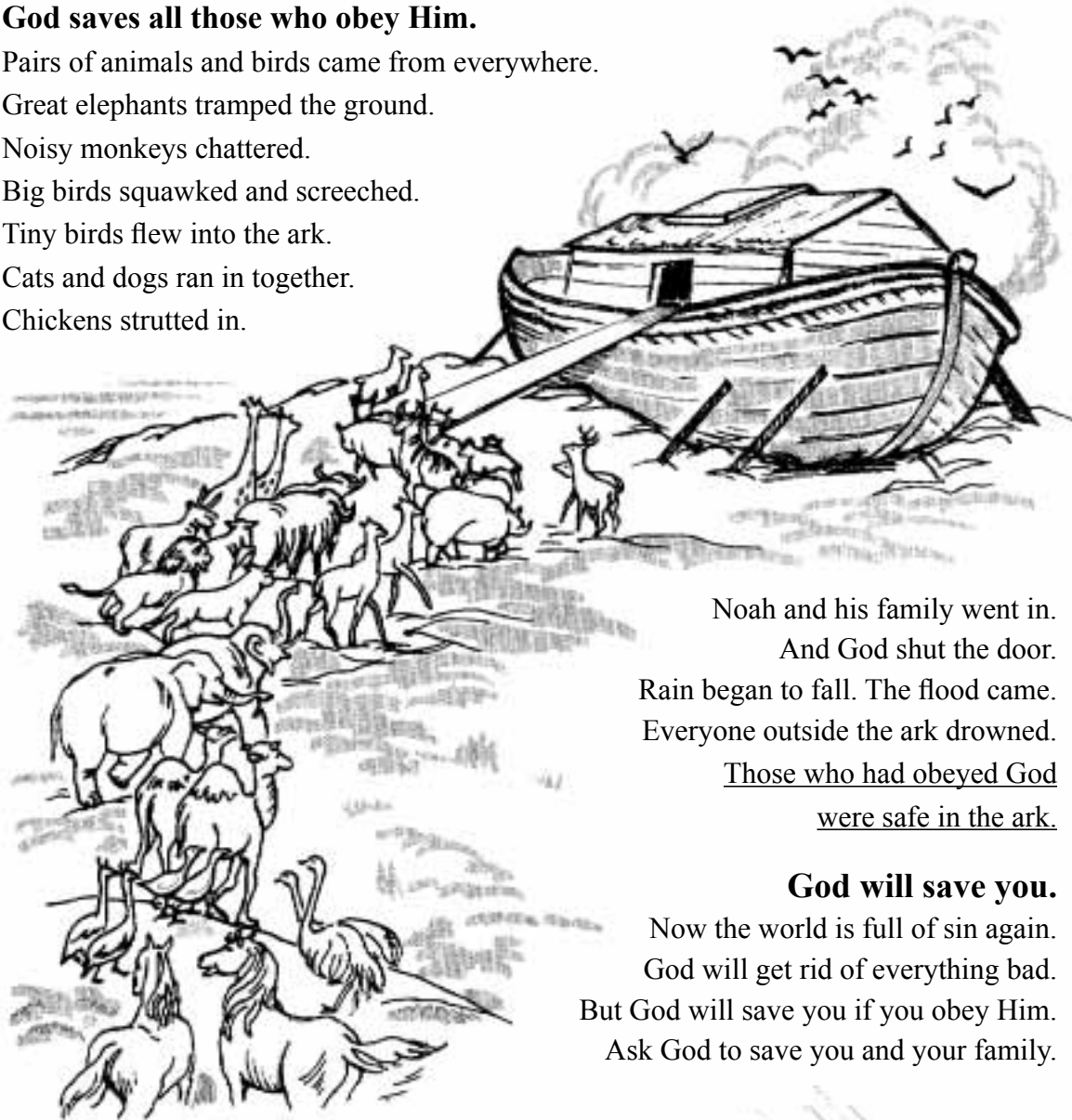


While Noah built the boat, the people laughed.

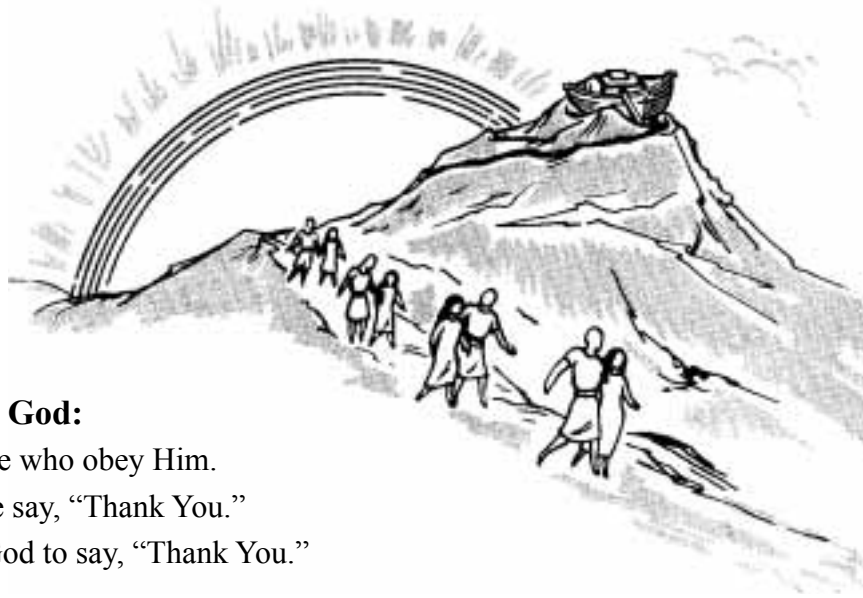

The animals were safe too.

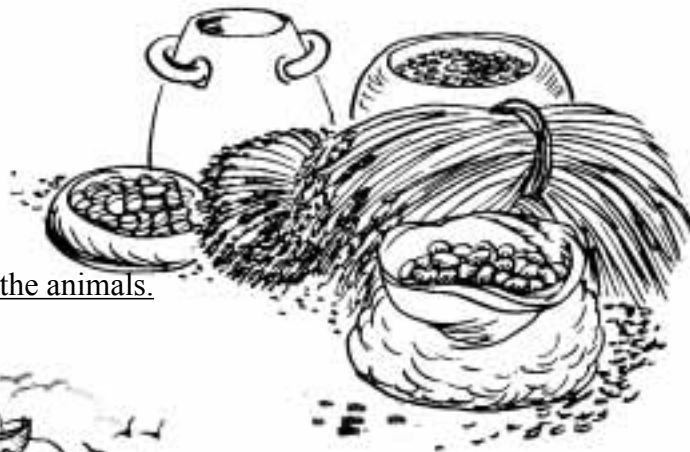
They had food to eat:

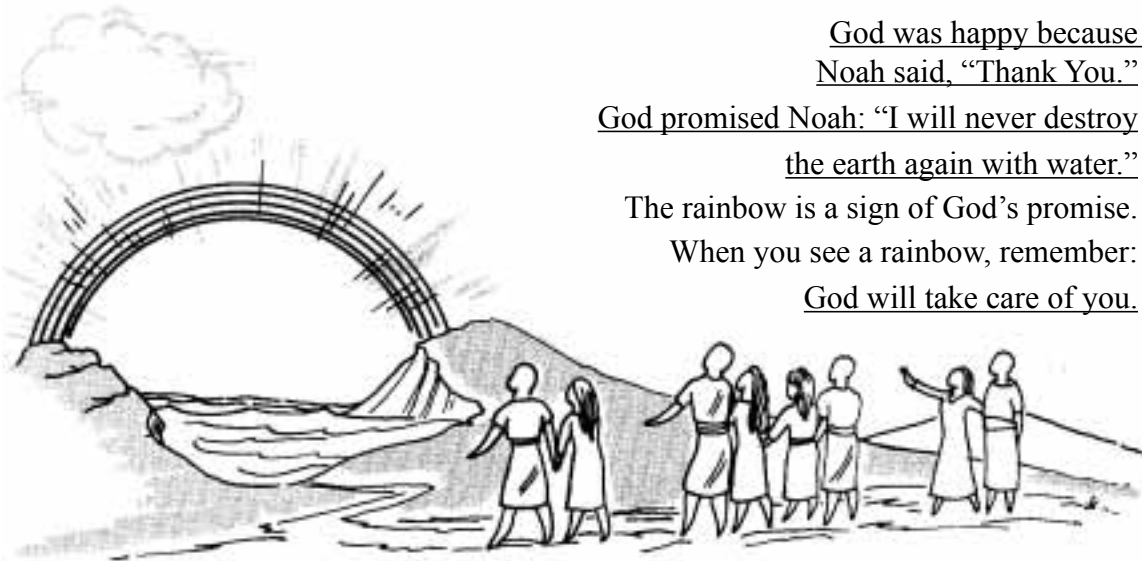

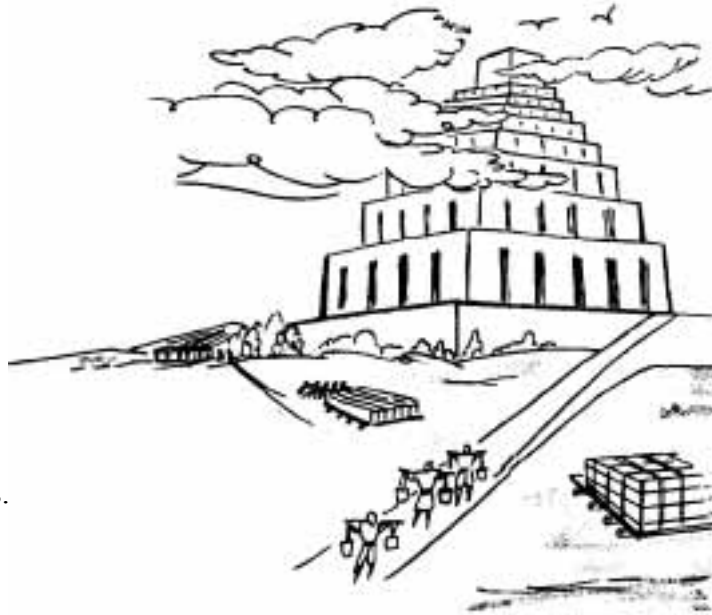

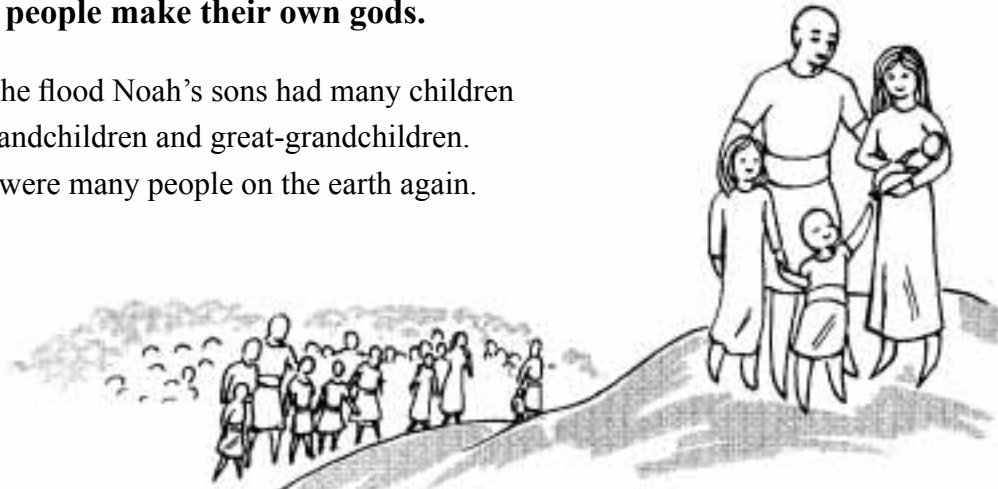

After the flood Noah's sons had many children and grandchildren and great-grandchildren. There were many people on the earth again.



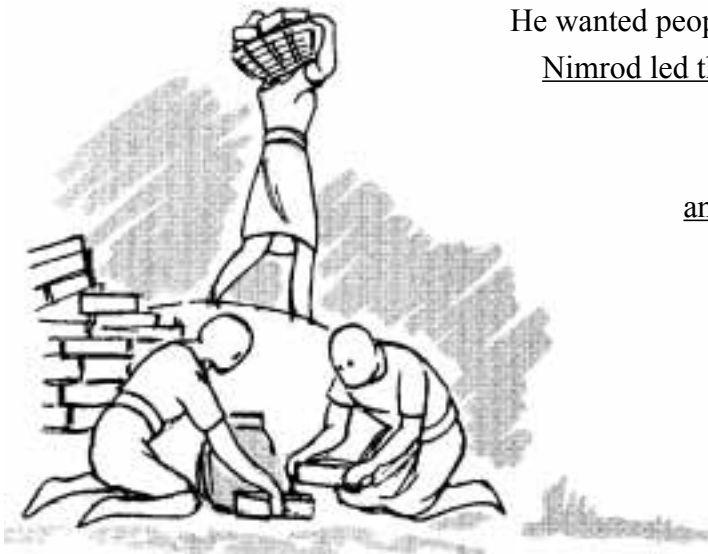
Noah and his sons told the people about God.
